For plating

- Metal drums and cans that have contained dangerous products are empty, washed and opened,
- The delivery does not contain filings and scraps containing oils or oily emulsions,
- Hollow bodies must be widely ripped open,
- No presence of iron oxide,
- No presence of turns.

For scrap metal to be sheared:

- The hollow bodies are largely disemboweled,
- No presence of iron oxide,
- No presence of turns,
- That the products are free from non-metallic materials (wood, tires, plastics for example).

For scrap metal to be cut:

- Tanks intended for torch cutting are accompanied by their degassing certificate,
- No presence of iron oxide,
- No presence of turns,
- The scrap metal is first decontaminated.

For non-ferrous metals:

- Metal drums and cans that have contained dangerous products are empty, washed and opened,
- Turnings and other scraps containing oils or oily emulsions should be stored in specific boxes for draining with recovery of the oils.
